School uniform

Just for your information, school uniform is:

Polo shirt or formal shirt in red or white

Jumper or cardigan in red

Skirts, pinafores and trousers in grey or black (summer dresses in red gingham)

Black school shoes

PE Kit- black shorts and white t-shirt, plimsoils and trainers. No logos or football shirts.

Trunks or a one-piece swimming costumes must be worn for swimming, no baggy shorts

Jewellery is not allowed in school except for simple studs & watches. All items must be removed for swimming, games and all physical activities, and children must be able to remove these themselves. School cannot take responsibility for jewellery brought into school

Please label all clothing with your child's name.

Payments

Payment for school lunches need to be paid in advance or on the day. If payments are outstanding for two weeks then a text will be sent as a reminder, after a further week a letter will be sent and

lunches will be stopped if the debt still remains unpaid and packed lunches will be required from this point.

Breakfast Club runs from 8am and is £2.50 per day, this is to be paid daily or in advance.

Visits can only take place if contributions from all families are paid. A decision will be made as to whether the visit takes place three weeks prior to the visit based on if all funds are in.

Attendance

It is crucial that all children attend school promptly at the start of the day 8.45am. Children can be on the playground from 8.35am when the staff will be present. School finishes at 3.30pm. FSU will exit from their playground, Y1 and 2 will exit from the 'back' door and Y3, 4, 5 and 6 from the main entrance. Staff are always present to ensure the children leave safely. All teachers are on the playground each morning and they escort the children in to school.

The Governing Body have adopted the Nottinghamshire policy for fining for poor attendance and holidays during term time. Please notify the office of any holiday absence. The school is obliged to notify the Local Authority who then issue the fines. School does not receive any of this money.

Please work with us to ensure good attendance as schools are judged on this and it can result in a school losing its 'good' OFSTED grade.

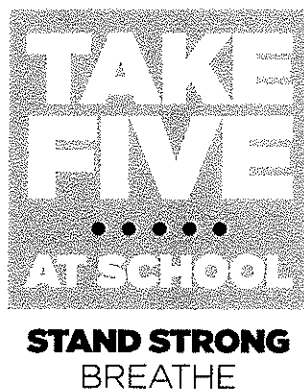
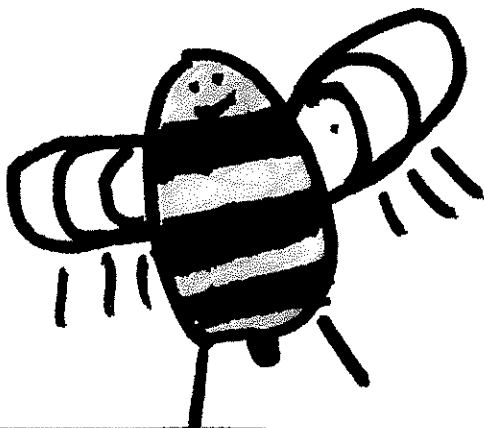
