

Governors

At Misterton Primary School there is a committed body of school governors who are crucial to the strategic development of the school.

Governors meet as a whole governing body at least 3 times a year. In between this there are meetings of the Finance, Pupil and Personnel and Strategic committees.

The Finance Pupil and Personnel committee monitors all financial aspects of school as well as supporting the school with pupil welfare and staff management. The strategic committee monitors the progress of children and the school improvement plan which relates directly to the most recent Ofsted inspection.

In addition to this the Head teacher and Chair of governors' work closely together meeting regularly to support the school and raise the profile of the governing body.

Governors regularly visit school, supporting and observing in the classroom, attending relevant training and assisting on school trips. As a mechanism to engage with parents/carers governors attend parents evenings, this provides useful feedback which informs governors of the experience families have with school.

At present the governing body consists of one staff representative (Mrs White), three parent governors, selected by parents, (Mrs Lucie McGrath, Mr Joshua Tylec and Mrs Sophie Newton); six co-opted governors (Mrs Jill Fairbank, Mrs Hazel Brand, Mr Jason Stanley, Mrs Gill Smith, Mrs Hayter and Mr Martin Belleini) and one local authority governor (Mr Ian White).
