Dear Parents and Carers,

We have trialled Concentration Aids (sensory toys) in school but now have had information about how these can be unsafe if they are not from a reputable source. As this would take time to evidence this, we have made the decision to stop children bringing in their own Concentration Aid. We will provide those children who have a sensory audit as part of their additional needs to have the right aid to support their identified need.

As always, no toys are allowed into school.

Summer 2026

- We have more events planned that are helping our school community to Take Care.
- We are bringing back **Mistertons Got Talent** and children will be encouraged to have a performance either as a solo or as a team. The final event will be on 26th June and families are invited to watch this. This day is also a non-uniform day to support our team prepare for the summer fayre.
- Our children will all transition up to their next class on the 29th June and will stay in their new class.
- From the 1st June we are encouraging children to be as independent as possible, with them moving classes four weeks after this half term. Please do all you can to support the children coming into school and when leaving school with the support of the staffing team.
- School starts at 8:45am and the children come across at 8:40am to be in school for register by 8:45am. School ends at 3:30pm for most children and at 11:45am

for nursery children. Children being collected early does upset other children and interrupts learning. Gates will not be opened early unless the permission to leave early as an exception is gained from Mrs Cappleman-Jackson.

- We would like to politely remind Parents that they are required to notify the school on the first day of any absence via telephone and leave a message or via email.
- Holiday request forms must be completed prior to any planned leave. A copy of the form is available on the school website or by contacting the school office.
