

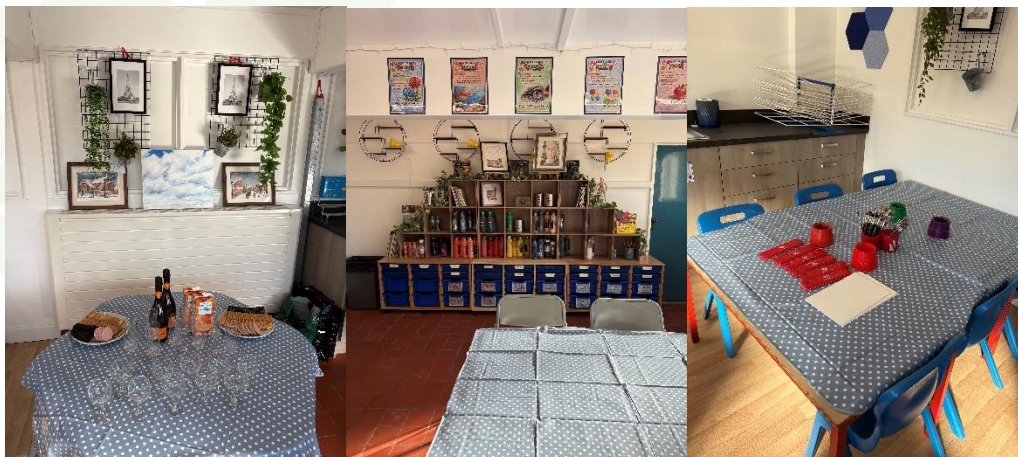
Spring Term March 2026 Newsletter.
